Year 6 – Visit to Didsbury Mosque - Wednesday 25th September

Dear Parents/Carers,

On the above date the children will be visiting the mosque in Didsbury as part of their RE curriculum for this term. We will be travelling there by tram. The mosque cannot accommodate us all at the same time so we have split classes as follows:

- 10am session (leaving school around 9am)
Class 6C and Class 6A (surnames from A-J)
- 11.15 session (leaving school around 10.15am)
Class 6B and Class 6A (surnames from K-Z)

The children can look forward to an informative session exploring the workings of the mosque with talks given by the staff and a tour of the building. Please note that trips form a compulsory part of our curriculum and therefore parents cannot opt their child out of them.

Lunch:

Please note that those children on the second session who have school dinners will be provided with a packed lunch as we cannot guarantee returning before the dinner hall closes. If your child is not on school dinners, please send an appropriate packed lunch for your child.

Payment:

We are asking parents/carers for a contribution of £1.50 per child to cover the cost of the tram. Payment can be made using School Spider. If we do not receive sufficient contributions the trip may have to be cancelled.

Clothing:

School jumpers or polo shirts are to be worn for the visit, as well as suitable footwear and a coat. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper, they will either be given one from the spares box or a high-vis jacket to wear so that they can be easily identified.
