Year 3 Trip to the River Mersey

On Thursday 10th October (9-12pm), we will be visiting the River Mersey as part of our Geography unit. We will be carrying out fieldwork where we will need to pick out key features of the river to embed our learning.

We will be walking to the River, via Chorlton Ees which is next to Brookburn Primary School. It will take us around 25 minutes to walk there, with a couple of hours fieldwork and we are aiming to return to school by 12.00pm.

We ask that all children are dressed appropriately for the trip. It can get muddy on the tracks and riverside so wellies or walking boots are advised, as is a waterproof coat. Please ensure your child is also wearing a red school jumper on the day of the trip. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper they will either be given one from the spares box or a high-vis jacket so that they can be easily identified.
