Year 5 Trip to Quarry Bank Mill – Thursday 7th November

We are excited to inform you that Year 5 will be visiting Quarry Bank Mill as part of our History unit. The trip will take place on Thursday 7th November. We will be taking part in a tour of the mill and engaging in an immersive experience at Apprentice House.

The cost of the trip is **£19.00** per child paid for via School Spider. If we do not receive sufficient contributions the trip may have to be cancelled. If your child is entitled to free school meals, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school.

School jumpers or polo shirts are to be worn for the visit. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper, they will either be given one from the spares box or a high-vis jacket to wear so that they can be easily identified.

We will be taking a coach to the venue and the trip will last the full school day. Please send an appropriate packed lunch for your child. If your child usually has school dinners, a packed lunch will be provided for them. If this applies, please ensure the school dinner option is selected via School Spider for the trip day.
