COMPASSIONATE



"We play with children in younger yeargroups- me and my friend check on the younger children at playtime, especially if they fall over and hurt themselves."

"We're always friendly towards other classmates, we always try to include everyone in our games and make them feel better if they get sad or hurt."

"The school always provides something that can help and comfort you, such as the regulation station, or specific members of staff that you can talk to if you need help."

"Sometimes we help people, if they need help doing something or they hurt themselves then we'll always show compassion by helping them. We do charity stuff in school by raising money for charity."

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COMPASSIONATE



"The eco team collect rubbish and recycle it, that shows compassion for the environment and the people in school."

"We are always respectful to other people in our classrooms and if someone is left out we always let them join in. In group work we are kind to each other."

"If someone is hurt or sad then I will help them and ask if they are ok. If they're not ok then I try and solve what's made them feel sad or hurt."

"If someone is hurt then we show that we care for them- once I fell over at breaktime and all my friends paused the game and asked if I was ok, everyone came in to help and check on me."
