"Art lessons make me feel creative because you're using your creativity to make pieces of art- I really enjoyed the World War 1 propaganda posters and the Islamic art and the David Hockney topic. I also liked the World War 2 art where we drew people in bunkers using water colours."

"Art makes me feel creative because art isn't just about how good you are, it's about your creativity. I liked my Islamic art star that I did, it made me feel creative when I was doing that. We learnt how to do the stars using pencils, then we could go over it in fine liner if we wanted to, and then when we had practiced it in our books we did it on a bit of canvas and we got to colour it in and did the background using colouring pencils."

"Art with Mrs Howells, and also in some of the other lessons we get to do drawing and express the way we feel, like in PSHE. Teachers are always respectful of that and push us towards creativity and using that to express ourselves."

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"We get to do DT and every year we get set the work but we get to add our own creative flair- for example, we made pizzas, and it was creative as we got to make it ourselves and add our own toppings."

"I love art- I feel like you can't really make a mistake in art, it feels like you're always able to do things your way, and it's a great way to teach kids. It lets you experience different ways of doing things, and you get to spend time doing your work the way you want to do it."

"In English we get to write lots of stuff that's using our imaginations and it's very creative."

"Art makes me feel creative- today we were adding to our research pages, which is like scrapbooking that we can add to using whatever medium we want to build on the topic we're doing, so at the moment we're doing about ancient Greeks and we needed to think about what ancient Greek artwork would look like today, which I found so fun."
