INSPIRED TO LEARN



"I like PE, because it's really fun and even if it's a sport we don't know that will it's still really fun. It makes me feel inspired to learn more sports, not just football or basketball, it makes me want to try everything."

"When we have a fun topic in history or we're doing an experiment in science, it makes me want to learn about the lesson. I really enjoyed World War 1 in history, and in science we did a good experiment where we compared two different slices of bread to see which one got mouldy faster."

"They always make lessons fun and you want to go into the lesson, you're never bored. I really like PE, English and history, they're my favourites and make me inspired to learn more about them."

"The way the teachers teach makes us feel really inspired to learn because it makes it enjoyable to learn and that makes you want to learn more. I like the way they make lessons funny and so it makes the lessons enjoyable."

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"In English we'll do a subject, like a book or something, and that makes me inspired to make my own book. For example, for World Book Day we made front covers of books in school, and it has inspired me to write my own book at home."

"I love that we have author visits, it's a great way to get thinking that we could be like that one day. It really helped me when I felt like my English wasn't good, it made me want to work really hard at it."

"I really like when we're doing maths, we have debates about the question, then we debate about what is the correct answer. That makes me feel inspired because I might feel like I should look at things another way to learn which one is correct."

"We had an ice hockey team come in and that was also very inspiring to me, hearing them talk about their sport. Also, one of our teachers is a former lacrosse player so I think she inspires people when she talks about that."
