**SELF-CONFIDENT**



**"Sports teams make me feel self-confident, because we're all working together and when we work together we try really hard and most of the time we win, which makes me feel confident for the other matches to come."**

*"When a teacher compliments my work it makes me feel good...There are also golden tickets, so we have a word of the week from our visioning words, and if the teacher thinks we've followed that word well then we get a scratch card. I got one for showing resilience."*

**"When you think you're bad at something the teachers always say that we're not and reassure us that we're the best we can be, and that makes me feel self-confident."**

**"Doing stuff independently makes me feel self-confident. For example, when I was writing a piece in English, it was a diary entry about the Olympics, it made me feel self-confident because I knew what I was doing and I didn't have to pause every second to think about what I was doing, I just felt confident in myself."**

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**"We get to mark our own work and when I get lots right it makes me feel self-confident. Also, if you're stuck you can ask the teacher for help, and they help you understand it properly which makes you feel confident you know how to do it for next time. We do a lot of independent work and that makes me feel consistent that I can do things without having to get help from the teacher."**

*"On World Book Day we got to present our costumes to the class and it was a nice chance to show off something we're proud of and for the rest of the class to show they appreciate it. It's a great way to make us feel happy about ourselves."*

**"I sometimes feel self-confident when I'm trying to do things I might not be as good at, as I might think I can't do it then I tell myself I can do it, and I push myself. Then usually I get quite a lot of things right and quite a lot of ticks on my work, and that makes me feel self-confident."**

**"The teachers are very good at letting you do things your own way, and they don't like us to use the word easy because they say it might not be easy for everyone, and the teachers are always congratulating us on our work."**
