

We asked the children what they do at school that makes them feel...



WELL-ROUNDED



"We do lots of different subjects, like English, guided reading, spelling, maths, but then we do stuff like PSHE, history and RE, it makes us well-rounded by getting to know every subject."

"I do dance afterschool club and drama, because I train a lot so I have lots of skills. We do a variety of subjects, like science and history and guided reading and Spanish, they give me lots of different types of skills."

"We do lots of different types of subjects, like English gives us skills that we'll use in the future for things like doing GCSEs and being able to speak and write well, and then things like PE can teach you resilience and compassion and teamwork."

"Most of the time we do lots of different subjects within a day, rather than just focussing on one subject. That gives us lots of different information and skills, not just looking at one subject and topic."

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"I love that you can tell that different teachers have different ways of teaching, like in maths there are different ways to get to answer and it means we can work out which is the best way to learn for us. We do a range of different subjects. Some people might not think music as important as maths, but that might be the subject that makes people happier and so it's so important that we do all the subjects."

"We do a big range of subjects, and I think we learn different methods, so if one method doesn't work for you can use another method that does. So the teaching suits everyone's learning styles."

"We did debates in English, and even though some of us wanted to be on another side, it made me realise even if you don't agree with something sometimes you can think about the other view."

"We learn lots of interesting things and it's fun to do it because our teacher makes the lessons fun so it makes us want to learn more."
